Hall Estill Ranked "Best Law Firm" In 2026 U.S. News And Best Lawyers®

After this thorough selection process, only a select number of firms received first-tier national and/or metropolitan rankings.

The first-tier rankings are featured in *U.S. News & World Report's* Money Issue and in the "Best Law Firms" stand-alone publication, as well as on its website and bestlawfirms.usnews.com. This year marks the eleventh edition of this highly-anticipated annual analysis.
